

PARKING FOR THE BROCKTON PUBLIC LIBRARY

Our 35 free parking spaces (including 2 Handicap spaces) fill up quickly, especially when we have multiple programs taking place in our busy library.

Across White Avenue from the accessible entrance is a parking lot that requires monthly parking permits to the left (as you pull in) and has parking meters to the right.

There are a few metered parking spaces on Main Street in front of the historic entrance.

There is a warehouse across White Avenue from our parking lot. The owners do not mind if you park to the right (as you pull in) along the edge facing the Salisbury River. They get frequent trailer truck deliveries so please don't block the loading dock or the loading bays. (See the picture below.)

A large parking lot is available, when ours is full, across Montello Street (Route 28) from the corner of White Avenue. Although there are "Permit Parking Only" signs, the Parking Authority has agreed to allow free parking for library overflow when our parking lot is full.
